

Rules

- Be kind to everyone
- Work hard
- Tell the truth
- Show respect to others
- Listen without interrupting
- Follow classroom rules
- Ask permission to leave the class
- Look after other people's property and school property
- No running in school
- Homework to be handed in on time
- Follow the adults instruction (eg keep off the grass)
- Do not leave the school grounds
- Do not take something that does not belong to you

If the children break a rule they may lose Golden Time on a Friday.



Behaviour

If a situation can be resolved through discussion, the child has not broken a rule and the teacher is happy with the outcome Golden Time *may* not be lost.

Rules

Children will get 1 warning for the rules. If the warning is ignored the child will lose 5 minutes Golden Time.

However

Rule – Be kind to everyone

If a child is unkind to others (eg hitting, spitting, nipping, bullying behaviour etc) and the teacher feels this is not acceptable, the child involved will lose 5 minutes Golden Time.

Rules for everyone's safety

Some rules are for the safety of everyone. If a rule is broken which may cause someone to be hurt the child involved may lose 5 minutes Golden Time. (eg leaving the school grounds)

Reward for keeping Tipperty Rules is up to 30 minutes Golden Time on a Friday.

Parents will be informed each Friday if their child has lost Golden Time and why. The slip must be signed and returned to the class teacher.

If a whole class does not lose any Golden Time for a week they will receive extra playtime on a Monday.
