Targets

At the beginning of each term targets will be set with the children. A copy will be made and put in the child's homework pack so parents are aware of the targets set and as a reminder for the children.

The targets will be evaluated by the child and teacher at the end of term. A copy will be sent home to parents

Learning Logs

Children will be involved in reflecting on their learning through talking to the teachers. They will record something about their learning on a learning log building up a picture of their successes, what they have learned and enjoyed in school.

Achievement Folders

Children will build up their personal learning throughout their time at Tippet Primary in a personal folder. This will be shared with parents.
