

# P1-4 Curricular Newsletter Term 1

The P1-4 topic this term is Farming. The children are learning about who works on the farm, the different uses of land, the different types of animals that are found on the farm and how this links to food production.

The curricular outcomes being covered are as follows:

*Having explored the variety of foods produced in Scotland, I can discuss the importance of different types of agriculture in the production of these foods*

*Having explored the landscape of my local area, I can describe the various ways in which land has been used.*

## Numeracy

Work this term covers place value, number patterns and work on position, movement and direction.
