This term P5-7 class are focusing on the topic of Titanic. The children are completing a novel study entitled “The Titanic Detective Agency” by Lindsay Littleson. The children will be researching the different classes of passengers aboard the Titanic and researching the history of some of the passengers. The children will be involved in a variety of writing tasks linked to the topic, including writing a newspaper article about the tragedy.

The main curricular outcomes being covered are as follows:
