Tipperty Parent Group

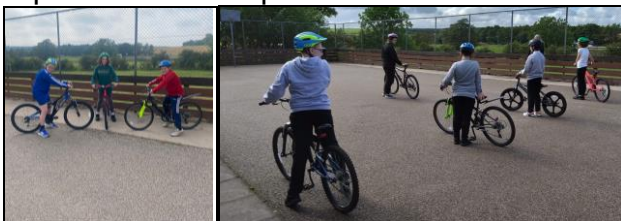
The Tipperty Parent Group Christmas Fayre will be held on Saturday 4th November from 10am to 4pm.
